- 1) NAME - The McCook Area Women's Bowling Association Hall of Fame
- 2) OBJECTIVE
 - a) The purpose is to perpetuate the names of those who have displayed outstanding ability in the game of tenpins, and/or...
 - b) They have contributed to the general welfare and progress of the game and also the McCook WBA
- 3) HALL OF FAME BOARD
 - a) The Board of Directors of the McCook Area WBA shall be the McCook Area Hall of Fame Board and shall have full control over the Hall of Fame Committee. The Hall of Fame Board shall supervise the Hall of Fame Committee in such a name as to insure a living, active, organization serving the purpose for which it was organized.
 - b) The Hall of Fame, an official function of the McCook Area WBA, shall be governed by a committee appointed by the President and consisting of the President, the Secretary, four (4) other board members, two (2) non-board members, two (2) Hall of Fame members (after induction), and one (1) proprietor. The committee shall have a Chairman and Recording Secretary appointed by the Association President from the committee members.
 - c) If a Hall of Fame Committee member is unable to attend the Hall of Fame election, the McCook WBA President will appoint a like member.
- 4) QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE NOMINEES
Participation, past or present, in organized leagues.
- 5) NOMINEES
 - a) No member may submit more than one (1) name per year.
 - b) All nominees' names must be submitted on an application form provided by the Hall of Fame Committee.
 - c) A name that has been submitted, but not selected, will automatically be resubmitted the following year, but for one (1) year only.
- 6) METHOD OF SELECTION
 - a) One member from each category, either living or deceased will be inducted at a meeting of the Hall of Fame Committee, where the members present will cast a secret ballot for not more than one (1) nominee per category.
 - b) It will require a seventy-five (75%) percent of the votes cast to be elected.
 - c) Should no one secure seventy-five percent of the votes cast, then a second ballot will be taken, using only three (3) of the nominees receiving the number of votes. If there is a tie for third place, all of those tying shall be voted on in addition to the two (2) highest.
 - d) Should one of the nominees receive seventy-five percent of the votes cast on the second ballot, she will be declared elected.
 - e) Should none of the nominees receive seventy-five percent of the votes cast on the second ballot, a third ballot shall be taken. The nominee receiving the most votes cast will be inducted.
- 7) AWARDS
A suitable award shall be made to those elected at a suitable ceremony. In case of posthumous awards, presentation will be made to the next of kin. A display of photographs of those elected or a plaque containing the names of those elected shall be displayed during the Annual City Tournament and at the McCook Area WBA Annual Meeting and other places of appropriate functions.

8) EXPENSES

The expense of the Hall of Fame Program shall be borne by the McCook Area Women's Bowling Association.

9) QUORUM

A quorum of all meetings of the McCook Area Hall of Fame Committee shall be 2/3 of the members.

10) AMENDMENTS

This constitution of Articles of Regulations may be amended by a 2/3 affirmative vote of the members, present at a meeting of the Executive Board of the McCook Area WBA, provided that any such amendment shall have been submitted in writing to the Secretary of the McCook Area WBA at least thirty (30) days before said meeting.
